I.B. Learning Aims & Goals

I.B. Learning Objectives

IB learning objectives are determined across four objective criterion:

- Criterion D: Responding

I.B. Grading Criteria

Students will receive a local grade which is percentage based and letter referenced.

Additionally, all IB objective criterion will be formally assessed twice throughout the year. These will be informally assessed on a continual basis. The success in the objective criterion is measured on a 0-8 scale. Limited competency is graded 1-2, adequate 3-4, substantial 5-6 and excellent 7-8.

A cumulative score is calculated for the year using the criterion scores and this is referenced on a scale of 1-7.



Local Grading Criterion

Students will receive a local grade, which is percentage based and letter referenced.
